





Now, it's my turn! The nice hygienist leads me into a room with a big lamp to see my teeth better and a chair that goes up and down.









X-rays help the hygienist see your teeth better. Can you help the nurse take the picture by finding your way through the maze?







## Cavities can make your teeth hurt, so that's why we need to brush our teeth.



Connect the dots to find the sugar bugs!









Once my teeth are clean, it's Dr. Bear's turn to see me.
